



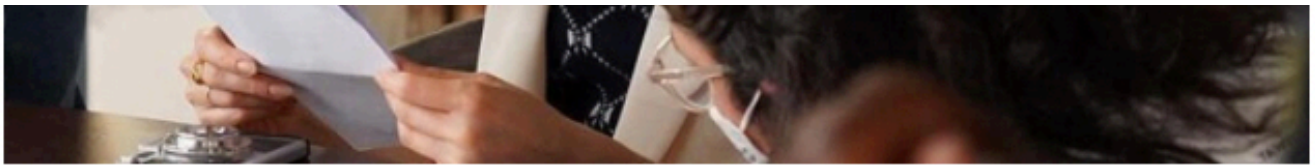

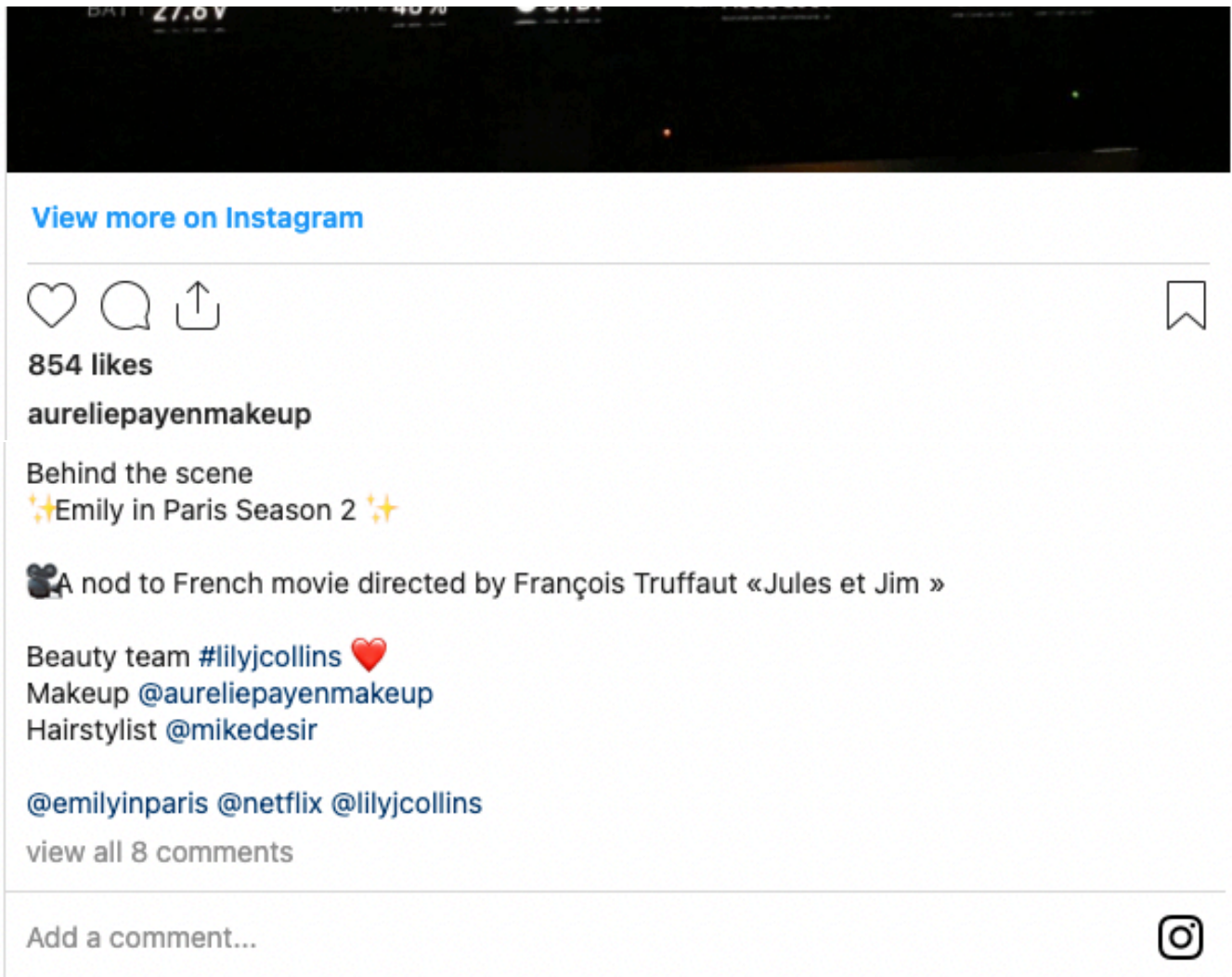

Aurélie always has a lot to say about makeup and in fact, she is a nominee for an award! Together with her team (Odile Fourquin, Aurélie Payen, Carole Nicolas, Corinne Maillard) she is nominated for the Make-Up Artists & Hair Stylists Guild Awards and specifically in the category: Best Contemporary Make-up in a Television Limited, Miniseries Or New Media Series . It's essentially the "Oscars" of makeup and when I congratulated her, asking her how she felt she said: "I am very happy, it was unexpected and, the nomination alone, is a great recognition for my work." Yes, she is so discreet and down to earth. So what did she have to say about the makeup of the second season at Emily in Paris?

In Season Two, Emily is confident. How does this translate into her makeup?

Emily matured at the end of the first season. Thus, in the second season she feels more comfortable in her new environment. We showed this - and it finally appeared - through her bold makeup choices. Also, French culture and beauty are beginning to become part of her personality.



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What was your inspiration for the looks ?

I got inspiration from Parisian makeup and look. I tried to focus even more on the French art of highlighting and enhancing natural beauty. Maintaining perfection for Lily's skin was my priority and skincare was the most important step, our daily ritual before makeup.

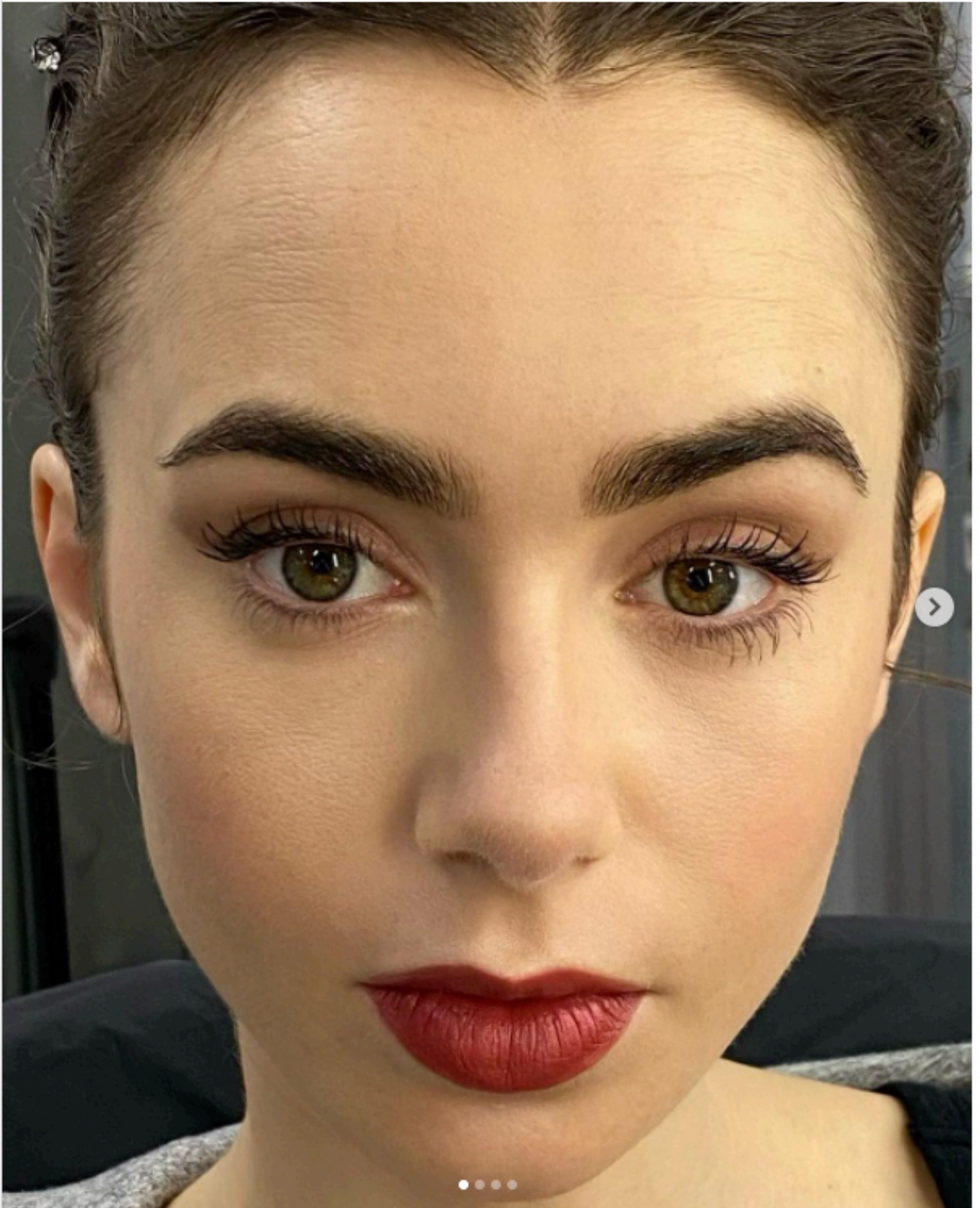
The beauty of Lily and consequently of Emily , is reminiscent of modern Audrey Hepburn . Was the legendary actress part of your inspiration?

What was your favorite makeup of the season?

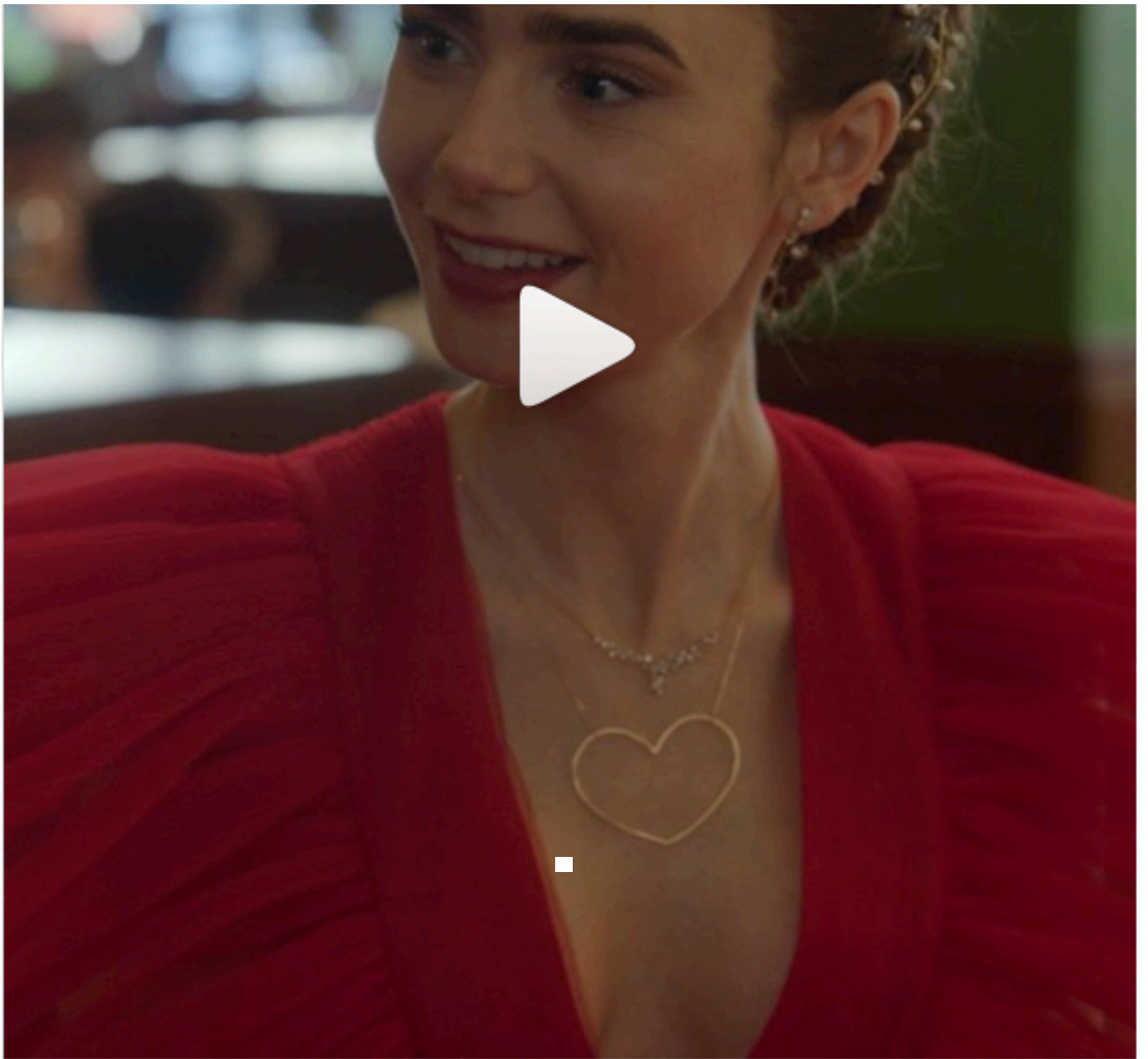
Definitely the Versailles look. Hairstylist Mike Desir, and I, were inspired by the Renaissance and gave a fresher, more modern twist. Perfect!
